



## 2019 Holy Week Schedule at St. Michael

**Palm Sunday:** 7 a.m., 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m., and 12:30 p.m. Mass.

On **Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday:** *Confessions* will be available in the evening at 6:30 p.m. *sharp*.

**Wednesday:** special Eucharistic holy hour with music and meditation by Mark Forrest at 7:30 p.m.

### **THE SACRED TRIDUUM**

**Holy Thursday:** *Mass of the Lord's Supper* will be at 7 p.m.

**Good Friday:** *Confessions* will be heard from 12 noon – 2:30 p.m.

*7 Last Words (Tre Ore)* from 12 – 3 p.m.

*Celebration of the Lord's Passion* will be at 3 p.m.

Good Friday is a day of **Fast & Abstinence**. *Fast* means one main meal per day and two smaller, meatless meals (that do not equal the large meal) for all between the ages of 18 and 59 (inclusive). *Abstinence* means no meat or meat products are to be eaten and is applicable to all who are 14 years or older. These are minimum standards for the observance of the Lenten penitential period of preparation and no Catholic may lightly excuse him/herself from them.

**Holy Saturday:** *Blessing of the Easter Baskets* will be at 9:30 a.m. on island in front of the church.

*Confessions* will be heard from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m.

\*\*\*There are NO *Confessions* from 3:30 – 4:30 p.m., or at 7 p.m.

### **ADORATION CHAPEL SCHEDULE**

The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed at 5 p.m. on Holy Thursday, and the Adoration Chapel will be closed. Directly after the Holy Thursday evening Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be returned to the chapel for adoration until Midnight. At Midnight, the Chapel will close and will remain closed through Good Friday and Holy Saturday until after the Easter Vigil Mass.
