## A Word from Fr. Drummond

One of the most mysterious figures of the Old Testament is Enoch son of Jared and the father of Methuselah (the longest lived man in Sacred Scripture). The Book of Genesis gives us a brief account, telling us that Enoch was the son of Jared who was 162 years old at the birth of Enoch and then lived an additional 800 years! Enoch himself fathered Methuselah at the

age of 65 and then "walked with God" for another 300 years. His story ends abruptly when Scripture repeats that "Enoch walked with God," then adding, "and he was not for God *took* him."

This is where it gets mysterious. For Jared, Methuselah and Lamech, Methuselah's son, Scripture notes that at the end of their years they *died*. But in Enoch's case, Scripture tells us, "and he was not for God *took* him." This is generally taken to mean that Enoch bodily went to Heaven, although the text is oblique. At the time God took Enoch he had reached an earthly age of 365. The notes in The Navarre Bible cite 365 as being a perfect number since it is the number of days in a year. At the time, Enoch's father Jared was still alive.

In the New Testament, there is a bit more clarity on Enoch's fate as we read in Hebrews 11:5, "By faith Enoch was taken up so that he *should not see death* and he was not found because God had taken him." Hebrews adds that Enoch had pleased God, and that this could only be done by faith. In the Epistle of Jude, Enoch is cited as having prophesied against the sinfulness of the people, but does not mention him being "taken."

There are a number of apocryphal books attributed to Enoch. These are of a later date and are not accepted as Scriptural (except in the Ethiopian Coptic Church was has an Ethopic version). These works are imaginative and sometimes interesting, but they really tell us more of what their anonymous authors believed than they tell us of the actual Enoch.


