A Word from Fr. Drummond

With the reopening of the Adoration Chapel, St. Michael's is pretty much returned to "normal." Perpetual Adoration has been a defining feature of St. Michael's for forty years. Over the years, however increasingly tight security has become necessary. While Perpetual Adoration will continue, the Chapel will only be open to the General Public between the hours of eight a.m. and eight p.m. (opening slightly earlier on weekdays). During the Church's "off" hours only those persons who are on the list and have been vetted will be given the entrance code. They are requested not to give it out and not to open the doors for anyone who may knock. Sadly, this is a security requirement for the volatile and uncertain times in which we live. Forty years ago the world was a

different place and we could safely remain open throughout the night. Those days are no more and we must cope as best we can.

I do encourage people to make use of the Chapel during the day even if only for a few minutes. Time spent with the Lord is time invested in our spiritual wellbeing. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is one of the great devotions of our Catholic Faith and we are especially blessed to have the Chapel open once again.

The Father's Day Spiritual Bouquet

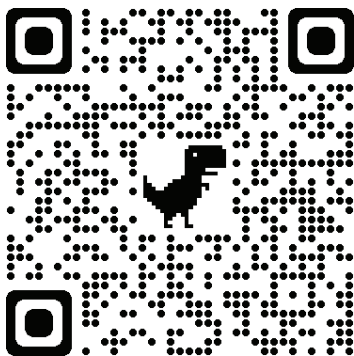
