A Word from Fr. Drummond

St. Michael's School has started up again. However, our numbers are lower than they have ever been, at an enrolment of 170. This is a crisis that affects the whole parish as it has driven our end of fiscal year deficit to a record high. There are two basic avenues we need to take to reverse this: increase the enrolment at the School, and, second, increase our weekly offertory. Earlier this year I started a new second collection — the Deficit Reduction Collection. This particular basket is passed around on all Sundays that do not already have an assigned second collection. This collection, however, can only be effective when what is donated is *over and above* what is usually given in the Main Collection: it has to be *in addition* to the Main Collection, not instead.

We are undertaking other efforts at increasing revenue, and these include monetizing the School gym and the Soccer Field. Another idea that I am kicking around (excuse the pun) is the possible establishment of an annual St. Michael's Run of perhaps five miles. What is crucial to all of this is the active participation in Parish Life of *all of our parishioners*.

On Sunday, September 20th, at four o'clock in the afternoon, we will hold our second Annual Town Hall Meeting. At this meeting I will address these and other issues in greater detail. Please mark the date and time and plan on being there.

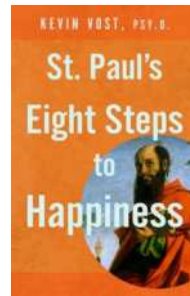
- **Weekly Giving:** If you selected weekly giving, your gifts will now be deducted each week instead of in one monthly batch.

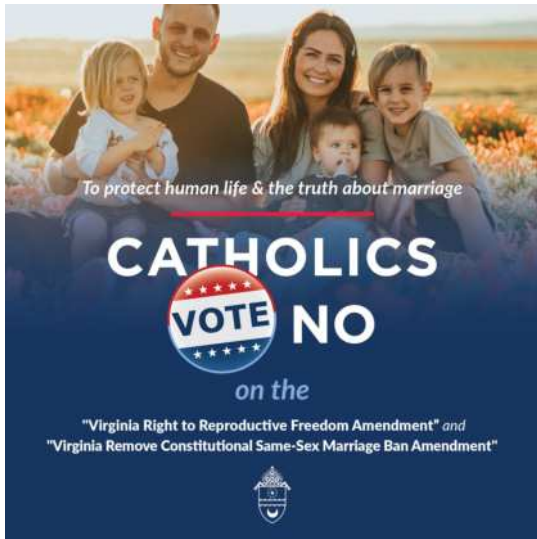

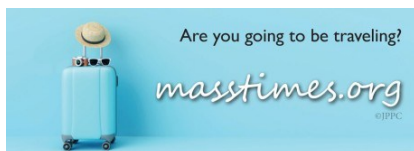
