CATECHISM 101: THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

In this course, you will learn about the natural and supernatural ways man can know God, the nature and forms of divine revelation, and the twelve articles of the creed.

CATECHISM 102: THE CHRISTIAN MYSTERY

With Rev. Msgr. Charles Pope

This course considers the nature and purpose of the sacramental economy and will study each of the seven sacraments.

CATECHISM 103: LIFE IN CHRIST

With Rev. Msgr. Charles Pope

In this course, you will learn about our calling to become participants in God's life, the order and purpose of society, the relationship of law and grace, and the moral implications of the Ten Commandments.

CATECHISM 104: CHRISTIAN PRAYER

With Rev. Msgr. Charles Pope

In this course, you will learn about the nature, traditions, and life of prayer. You will also study, in-depth, our Lord's prayer: the Our Father.

CATECHISM 201: THE ART OF CATECHESIS

With Jared Staudt, Ph.D.

This course considers the history, principles, and methods of catechesis and how we can employ them within the growing challenges of a secular culture. Students will learn how to teach the faith using the Bible and Catechism, complemented by an approach of evangelization and discipleship.
